Parent Duty Agreement & Privacy Statement



Croydon Little Athletics Centre (CLAC) is totally dependant on the assistance of parents to run its structured program on a week by week basis. Each week our athletics program requires the assistance of 120 parents to ensure the smooth and efficient running of the activities. This takes a lot of organizing and requires a parent/guardian from each family to get involved in carrying out duties in accordance with Club Policy to make each Event Day a success.

In the past couple of years, with the increase in athlete numbers, it has been observed that much of this workload has been left to the more committed parents. A decision has therefore been made by the Croydon Little Athletics Centre Executive Committee to introduce the following requirements.

ELIGIBILITY FOR END OF YEAR CLUB TROPHIES AND CENTRE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Parent Responsibilities:

- **Parent or Guardian must be present at all times.**
- By accepting this agreement, you agree to carry out your Clubs rostered allocation of duties.
- You are able to swap your allotted duty however it will be your responsibility to ensure another parent fulfills your duty time and the Team Recorder will need to be notified prior to a swap being completed.
- A list will be maintained by each Club throughout the season to ensure that all families do their 'fair share' of duty, thus enabling **all parents** to enjoy the experience of actively supporting their children and their achievements.
- If you fail to fulfill this duty, or you are unable to commit to this duty requirement, you may directly impact your child's eligibility to compete in Centre, Region or State Championships

Athlete Responsibilities:

- Athletes must compete at 60% of Competition Days (in a minimum of 3 Events) on these days. Each Club will take into account special requests (eg Injury or special family circumstances).
- Athletes that compete at Box Hill Relays, Region & State Events and wish to have the Competition Day / Night off prior to the Event will be marked as attending.

REQUIREMENTS WHEN COMPETING AT REGION / STATE COMPETITIONS

Parent Responsibilities:

- Parents of all attending athletes must agree to do duty at both Region / State Competitions.

Athlete Responsibilities:

- Athlete must have competed at 60% of the Croydon Competitions Days.
- Athlete must wear correct Centre Uniform.
- Relays (Child must attend Training regularly to be part of the Relay Team).
